




MANUAL IMPOSITION - DUTCH CUT LAYOUT



- 1) Open up your PDF document

In this Example, I have opened up a 18 page (6" x 11") PDF document and I would like to create a Dutch Cut Layout (Gang) to save ink and paper on a 12.5" x 18" sheet.

Note: I'm Using NEW Features in Quite Imposing Plus 3.0 to do this Job. Earlier versions could do Manual Imposition however, the New version has an Undo Button to help if you make a mistake and all Manual Sequences (XMLs) can now be saved And Exported to Quite Hot Imposing 3.0 if Needed.

- 2) To access Quite Imposing Plus, simply Select >**Plug-ins** and then >**Quite Imposing Plus** from Acrobat's **Menu bar**. Alternately, selecting >**Plug-ins** from the **Menu bar** and then >**Quite Imposing Plus** >**Imposition Control Panel**.
- 3) Click or Select **Manual Imposition...** button A dialog box will appear.





In this Example, you need to pick a **Target Sheet** (this lets you set what size sheet your outputting on)

- 4) Click **Change target...** button to continue A dialog box will appear.

In this Example, I have selected to Create a new document with **6** sheets at 12.5" x 18".

*Note: If you don't have 12.5" x 18" created it's easy to do. Select **More choices...** from the pop-up. Now indicate Width 12.5 and Height: 18 It's also good to name it: In my Example, I just called it 12.5" x 18" Click OK button it is Now added to the pop-up list and easy to access.*

5) Click or Select **OK** button
Note: You now have your Output sheets.

6) Next you need to Click **Pick Source...** button.

7) Click the **Pick** button. A Dialog box Appears And you can Pick the PDF you are going to drop on to your output sheets.

*Note: Click **Next doc >>** button unless the PDF document is already opened. You should also notice once you do this a highlighted Color should appear on your output sheet. Place it where you'd like using controls.*

*In my Example
 Offset • Top left Horizontal .125
 Vertical .125*

8) Click **Add page** button

9) Now Click **Pick source...** button again, and pick the same source document. You can place the same document or the next page it's up to you. I placed (Inserted) page 2:
 • Top left Horizontal: 6.35 and Vertical: .125
 Click **Add page** button

10) The last page for this sheet placed the same way, except the placement of page is:
 • Rotate 90 CCW
 • Top Left Horizontal: .75 Vertical: 11.375
 Click **Add page** button

11) Now you can continue till all 18 pages are laid out and you can save all the steps using Automation Sequences (as XMLs).

12) You can also Print or Save your document.
